



## Eardy Mae Bunch

April 21, 1929 - August 22, 2020

Eardy (Erdie) May Bunch, age 91, went to be with her Lord on Saturday, August 22, 2020, at the Keswick Long-Term Care facility, a loving and caring community in Baltimore, Maryland; Ms. Bunch had been in poor health for many years. Prior to entering the nursing home, she resided at the Brentwood Apartment complex on East 25th Street in Baltimore.

Eardy was born at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, April 21, 1929 in Rocky Mount, North Carolina to Webster Daniel Bunch and Emma (Baldin) Bunch and was the fourth of five children, all now deceased.

She was very camera shy, loved good food, and was partial to crab cakes.

She is survived by her devoted cousin, Deloris Smith of White Plains, Maryland; cousins, Carolyn Duggans of Georgia and Jessica Tyson of Maryland; extended family members; a host of friends and her beloved Ebenezer Church family.
