



Earl M. Spruill

January 29, 1944 - July 5, 2020

Earl Michael Spruill was the only child of Earl and Edith Bowser Spruill, born on January 29, 1944. He was 76 years old. He was born and raised in Baltimore, Maryland.

His parish growing up was St. Pius Catholic Church on Edmondson Avenue and Schroder Street. St. Pius was eventually closed some years ago.

Earl went to Baltimore City College for high school and graduated in 1961. During high school, he played the organ for mass and weddings during 1960/1961. He then went to the Peabody Conservatory where he studied to become a classical organist and music teacher, graduating in 1965. During the summers while at Peabody Conservatory, he took classes at the Catholic University in Washington DC. He earned his Master's Degree at Morgan State University. Prior to becoming organist at St. Joe, dad played the organ for the music department's choir at Morgan State University for about 17 years.

He was a music teacher for Baltimore County public schools for 35 year. He started teaching music in 1965 at Sparrows Point Junior High and then he went on to Sudbrook Junior High before retiring at Deer Park Middle School. After retiring, dad taught at St. Joe too. He really enjoyed the younger children at St. Joe—he had spent his career with teenagers so it was a delightful change for him.

Earl married Agatha Blair, on July 8th, 1967. They had Michelle, one daughter, Michelle, on October 31, 1968.

Earl is also survived by one granddaughter, Mecia Neverdon; two great grandchildren, Mariah and Mackenzie (ages 9 and 10). Michelle, Mecia, Mariah and Mackenzie live in Atlanta, Georgia.
