EARNESTINE COURTS ROBERTSON was born April 23, 1928, in Greensboro, North Carolina to the late Willie and Rachael Courts. Earnestine attended the public school system in North Carolina until high school. At the age of fifteen, she moved to Baltimore with her Aunt Hattie. She postponed her education at that time to begin working; however, she later attended the Dunbar Adult High School and received her diploma on May 27, 1965.

While working as a waitress, she met and married Willie Kinard on September 19, 1945. From the marriage, they had three children: Larry Willie Kinard now deceased, Joyce Ann Kinard now deceased and one surviving son, Wayne Kinard. They remained married until July 17, 1970. He met and then married her second husband, Columbus Robertson on August 29, 1970. They were happily married until his death on August 8, 2001. She was a devoted mother and wife.

Her life in Baltimore was full and vivacious. Earnestine was a lively person and enjoyed being involved. She was an active member at Ceasar Memorial Freewill Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend Leo Ceasar. Later in life, she became an associate member at LIFE Church Ministries in Baltimore.

In addition to her church involvement, she was the affairs coordinator for the

fabulous Golden Girls of Baltimore. She enjoyed traveling to various gospel programs throughout the south and east coast.

She enjoyed working with children and worked as housekeeper and childcare provider for various families throughout Baltimore. During her many years of work, she accepted a job with Baltimore City Schools dietary support services. Earnestine worked twenty years in the dietary department at Cecil Elementary School. She received multiple awards for her excellent service and devotion to the school. She retired from Baltimore City municipal in 1993 at the age of 65.

She is survived by her son, Wayne Kinard; grandson, Wayne Cardas Kinard Jr.; sisters, Ardelia Matthews and Armentha Moragne; a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
