



Eddie A. Jennings Sr.

October 16, 1944 - April 18, 2019

EDDIE ADOLPHUS JENNINGS was the seventh of fourteen children born to the late John Ed and Hester Ann Jennings. His father, mother and sister Shirley Jennings preceded him in death. Eddie made his transition into eternity on April 18, 2019.

Eddie was born October 16, 1944 in Charleston, MO. His family relocated to Wardell, MO in 1946 where he attended and graduated from Hodgen Elementary School. He attended Hayti Central High School for three years, and graduated from North Pemiscot High School in Wardell where he was a Drum Major. After high school graduation, Eddie went to live and work in Baltimore, MD.

Eddie was drafted into the U.S. Army in July of 1965 and served in the Vietnam War as an Armour Crewman and a Combat Engineer. He was honorably discharged on July 13, 1967, and received a National Defense Service Medal, a Vietnam Service Medal, and the Vietnam Campaign Medal. Eddie served in the Reserves until July 20, 1971. He returned to Baltimore where he worked and lived until his death.

Eddie married Wynoina Long of Baltimore in 1968. To this union was born one son, Eddie Jr. Eddie Jr. and his wife, Angellette Simms, have two sons, Jamal and Jordan and one daughter, Angellette. Eddie Sr. later married Charlene

Foster on December 31, 1988. To this union was born one son, Resha. Resha has one son, Resha Jr. and two daughters, Donyea and Nashea Jennings.
