EDITH GORDINE BLOUNT was born in Baltimore, Maryland on June 12, 1926, the only child of Gordon Carrington Jones and Edith Harvey Brown Jones, both of Baltimore.

Gordine, as she was called, named after her father Gordon, graduated from Douglass High School in June 1944. She earned her BA degree from Fisk University in Nashville, Tennessee and a M.Ed from Towson State University in Baltimore, Maryland. In 1950, she married the late Oswald E. Chisholm. From this union, she had two sons, Oswald Edward Chisholm, fondly known as "Chipper" and Mark Gordon Chisholm who both preceded in death.

Gordine worked as a social worker for the Baltimore City Department of Social Services, the Nashville Tennessee Housing Authority, the Chicago Department of Social Services, The Chicago Housing Authority and ending her career with 28 years of service in the Baltimore City Housing Authority. She was an active Golden Soror of Epsilon Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, and a former member of Carats, Inc and Epicureans, Inc.

Upon her retirement in 1989, Gordine shared her talents and expertise with many state, city and private boards. She was a Trustee and life long member of Grace Presbyterian Church. She enjoyed quiet dinner parties with close friends, and the company of her grandchildren.

In 1966, she married the late Senator Clarence W. Blount. These two complimented each other in their loving ways and belief in giving back to the community. She is survived by: Stepson Michael Blount; grandchildren, Damien Chisholm and Markita Chisholm; great-grandchildren, Damien and Denae Chisholm; daughter-in-law, Demetrius Chisholm; nephew, Roy E. Owens, Jr. and many friends and acquaintances.
