Edith Geraldine Pugh, the elder daughter of Lindsay and Editha Douglas, was born on April 20, 1954, in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on August 29, 2015.

At an early an age, she took great pride in learning. Edith received her education in the Baltimore City Public School System. On June 16th , 1972, she graduated from Eastern High School. Determined to strive for a higher education, she continued pursuing her studies at Towson State College from September 1972 until June 1976.
