EDMOND THOMAS MCINTYRE, son of the late Charles Thomas McIntyre and Lucy Martin McIntyre, was born on June 2, 1953, in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on April 27, 2017.

Edmond was educated in the Baltimore City Public Schools. After graduating high school at the Baltimore Polytechnic Technical Institute in 1971, he attended the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he studied English, Black History and Physical Education.

Later, Ed attended RETZ Technical Center in Baltimore where he graduated with a certificate in Architectural Drafting and Design that landed him as engineering technician in a local firm engineering.

Ed was an avid health and fitness enthusiast and vegetarian. He stayed exceptionally fit, working out, and lifting weights regularly, to strengthen his body. He ran cross-country and was a high-jumper. But his first love was wrestling. Ed competed in wrestling tournaments both at the high school and college level. He placed high in the Maryland Scholastic Association Wrestling Championship while at Poly. He was a proud member of Riley Hawkins Avengers Karate School and boxed at Murphy Homes, competing well in tournaments in both disciplines.

Edmond was a devoted brother, mentor and loyal friend. There was nothing he felt you could not achieve if you were willing to work hard.

He leaves to mourn his passing: three brothers, Ronald E. McIntyre of Lorton, Virginia, Vernon R. McIntyre of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania and Kevin L. McIntyre of Bowie, Maryland; two sisters, Carolyn Wilson and Karen V. McIntyre; one sister-in-law, Michelle S.
