



## Edmund J. Mack, Sr.

January 30, 1947 - November 1, 2025

EDMUND JAMES MACK SR. was born January 30, 1947, in Baltimore, Maryland, to the late Odell and Isadora Mack. Edmund Sr. grew up on the South side of Baltimore.

After graduating high school, he would later meet and marry Mrs. Janice Aboney. He would then leave to serve his country in the United States Marine Corps, later returning to his then wife and three children. He was gainfully employed with the International Harvester Truck Company, from which he retired after 37 years of service. Later in life, he met his long-term partner, the late Ms. Muneerah Shabazz. They were partnered for 43 years until her unfortunate passing.

Edmund Sr. was a long-term member of Apostolic True Foundation Church of Jesus Christ, under the leadership of the late Bishop Verleen Doughty, where he and his five brothers Larry, Glen, Terry Mack, Clinton Dixon and Herman McClinton all sang with the Male Chorus for over three decades.
