Edna received her elementary and high school education in Florence, South Carolina and later attended Howard County Community College. She was employed at several businesses in the Baltimore area including the South Baltimore Family Health Center, Cherry Hill Multipurpose Childcare Center, Baltimore City Health Center and the Howard County Department of aging.
