Elder Edward Lee Burt, Sr. of Henrico County was born July 22, 1935 in Richmond, VA to Sylvester Crenshaw and Jessie Burt Logan. He accepted Christ at an early age and faithfully served the Lord in the ministry at Resurrection Lutheran Church, LCMS in Richmond, VA. He attended Maggie L. Walker High School in Richmond, VA, then enlisted in the United States Army where he served in the Korean War.

The Lord blessed Edward with the gift to work with his hands, where he took on the trade of sewing and had a successful career as a Master Tailor. He refereed for the Central Virginia Football Official's Association for 25+ faithful years. Edward is affectionately remembered for telling his many stories and jokes. 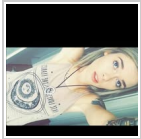

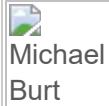

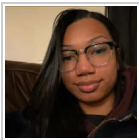
