Edward "Eddie" Blake, was born to the late Raymond and Helen Bush on December 21, 1935 in Baltimore, MD. He departed this life on January 30, 2021 after a brief illness.

He received his education from the Baltimore City Public School System and graduated Carver Vocational High School with emphasis in Tailoring and Design in 1954. Eddie enlisted in the U.S. Army June 16, 1955, where he served in Company F 501 St Airborne Infantry Regiment in Fort Jackson, SC. This experience afforded the opportunity to tour the world and enjoy places such as Germany and China. After an honorable discharge from the U.S. Army, Eddie shared his talents with The Can Company, Sparrows Point and later retired from Allied Chemical.

At a young age, Eddie accepted The Lord as his savior. With great faith, he served as a Deacon at New Shiloh Baptist Church under the original Pastor, Dr. Harold A. Carter, Sr.

Eddie had a "carefree spirit". He loved fishing, sports, world news and donating to various charities. He often called his son-in-law, "Baldie", to commentate on Serena Williams, The Orioles, Ravens, Colts, and world events. He also beamed with pride when recapping his grandson and the Denver Nuggets.

If you asked Eddie, his greatest accomplishment wasn't his work or military history or love of sports, news or fishing, it was being a father and grandfather. Eddie met Clarcy and it was love at first sight. That love grew to include six children. After they married in 1958, they lovingly added two more, becoming a party of 10.

Eddie leaves to cherish his memory: Daughters; Bonita, Karen, Cynthia and Laretta. Grandchildren; Sharina, William, Antonio, Derrick, Latonya, Tamara, and Nakia (Rolmarc); nineteen great - grandchildren and four great-great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his daughters Kathy, Denise and Robin and son Ronald.
