Friday afternoon, February 9, 2018 at Season's Sinai, EDWARD LEROY GREEN serenely slipped away into eternity after a month-long battle with illness.

Edward, "Eddie" to his friends and family, was born on July 18, 1939 in Baltimore, Maryland. He was the first born to the newly married Frances Anita and Walter Leroy Green. Edward's biological father, Henry Jones, was believed to have been missing at sea while serving in the U.S. Navy.

Eddie received his education in the Baltimore City Public School System. Afterwards, in 1956, he signed up for the military and served about 2-1/2 years, including a tour in Germany. These experiences profoundly impacted Edward and lead him to pursue a career in law enforcement which included such jobs as armed security and private detective. These were his passions.

Edward accepted Christ as his Savior many years ago and actively served his Lord as an "usher", "choir member", and "servant as needed". Also, for some time, he was a member of the Mighty Zions Gospel Singers who performed throughout the Baltimore metropolitan area. He loved to sing and study the Bible.

In September of 1985, Edward Leroy Green and Doretha Pringle were united

in holy matrimony. This union remained until Doretha's passing in 2012. While no children were born of this union, Edward did gain a step-daughter.

Edward fathered four children throughout his life: daughter, Valerie Patricia Green (deceased) and three sons. He is survived by: his sons, Terrence Green (Monica), Edward F. Green, and Maurice Turner; stepdaughter, Jackie Pringle Campbell (Henslee); sister, Frances A. Miller (John); brother, John W. Greene (Sandra) of Philadelphia, PA; sister-in-law, Ruby Pringle Moore (Ivory); four brothers-in-law, Willie Pringle (Janet) of NC, Robert Pringle (Dorothy), Hesikiah Pringle (Burnett), Richard Pringle (Janet) of MI; nine grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren, one step grandchild; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles, and friends.
