Edward Lewis Jackson, born April 20, 1949, the oldest son of Edward Ulysses Jackson and the late Vivian Elizabeth Jackson, departed this life on November 4, 2015.

Edward, affectionately known as "Ed", was born and raised in Baltimore City and was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. After graduating from Douglass High School, he enlisted into the United States Air Force.

On June 29, 1968, Ed married the love of his life, Sheila Louise Jackson, who preceded him in death. Their union lasted thirty-five years, and blessed them with four daughters, six grandchildren, one great-grandson and one great-grandson on the way.

After serving his term in the United States Air Force, Ed joined the Baltimore City Police Department, then later joined the Maryland State Police Department, and lastly served as a federal officer in the United States Library of Congress.

After years of being a public servant, he decided to become an entrepreneur. He created, owned and operated one of the most successful private process service companies in Baltimore. He later expanded his business to include

transportation services. During his almost thirty years of business, Ed provided job opportunities for many of his family members. He provided services to many law firms in the Greater Baltimore Metropolitan area and was widely known for his accuracy and dependability. 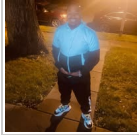
