Edward John Beldo was born November 5, 1930 to the late William and Rose Beldo in Brooklyn, New York. He obtained his education in Brooklyn, New York. As a teenager he was adopted by the late Lorenzo Davis, his mother's second husband. Edward J. Beldo-Davis, also known as "Big Ed" worked for Kim Transfer for more than 25 years. He married Alberta Capsules Bailer in 1971 and two worlds became one. In 1971 he established his own truck hauling company, "E. Davis and Sons, Inc." That's when he became the first African American to sign a contract with Amstar Corp. hauling Domino Sugar to all states. He opened a lot of doors for all people. For in his 21 years with Amstar, he hired black, white and red. "Color" didn't matter if you wanted to work. His "employees" became an extension to his family. Big Ed, Dad, Pop-Pop, My Big Brother, and "Daddy" was a very rich man, and all our lives are richer for having shared his space. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Alberta Cassell Davis; two daughters, Melvienia and Tina; four sons, Eddie and Eric Davis, and Melvin and James Baylor; sister, Evelyn Brown; brother, Lorenzo Davis; mother-in-law, Anna Hayes; two aunts, Edith and Gladys Beldo of Brooklyn, New York; five sisters-in-law, Ida, Bernadette, Bernice, Beatrice, and Doveretta; three brothers-in-law, Lawrence, Woodrow, and James Cassell; thirteen grandchildren, fourteen great grandchildren, as well as a host of nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends.
