Eddie began his work career in the garment industry in New York City. He retired in 1996 as a partner in Adair's Amoco Food Shops and Service Stations. Eddie's warm smile and gentlemanly personality won over many faithful customers. His heart of gold and words of wisdom endeared him to all who passed his way. His loyalty to his brother Carl in business affairs as well as brotherly love made for a partnership that was beautiful for all to see. Eddie was the epitome of a man; a devoted husband and father, always putting the well being and happiness of family above his own. His greatest passion was getting together with family. What joy to remember last September 25th when a host of family and friends gathered to celebrate his 75th birthday. All saluted
