



## Edward Richardson

October 22, 1930 - October 17, 2018

On Tuesday, October 16, 2018, God called another one of his soldiers home to rest. At last he could be free from trials, tribulations, and pain.

Edward Richardson, the son of the late Jack Richardson and Sylvia Williams, was born October 22, 1930 in Wake County, NC. One sister, four brothers, and one grandson preceded him in death.

Edward was educated in the Wake County Public School Systems. After completing his education, Edward enlisted in the armed forces, and was honorably discharged. He served his country well. After leaving the armed forces, Edward moved to Rocky Mount, NC where he met the love of his life, Dorothy Cooper. Edward later moved to Baltimore, MD, after which he became employed by the AFL CIO United Workers Union for twenty-five years. In March, 1957, Edward and Dorothy were united in holy matrimony.

Edward, realizing that one day he would need a home not made by man, accepted Christ as his personal Savior. On July 12, 1957, Edward united with the Mt. Ararat Baptist Church, Baltimore, MD, where he served as an usher and choir member. In addition, he worked with the Mt. Ararat Boy Scouts. Later, Edward was unable to be active due to failing health.
