Elder Edwin Jerome Goodall was born in Richmond, Virginia on May 31, 1959. He entered eternal reward on Thursday morning July 11, 2024. He was preceded in death by his mother, Constance R. Goodall and father, James A. Goodall. He was the third child of four children.

Edwin was educated in Richmond City Public Schools graduating from Maggie L. Walker High School. In elementary school He began learning music by playing the trumpet. After high school he attended Shaw University of North Carolina. He graduated Summa Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Arts degree in music. Later, he earned a master's degree from Phoenix University. He taught himself to play the piano but also manifested a divine gifting to do so.

Edwin received JESUS CHRIST at an early, age. He was a Boy Scout and a Scout leader. He grew up at Sharon Baptist Church and served there as musician, in the youth ministry and on the Trustee Board. In 1984 he joined Manna Christian Fellowship Church where he served as a Deacon, Elder, Youth Ministry Leader, Head of the Music Ministry, School Administrator and Principal, The Food Pantry, Foreign Missions and the Intercessory Prayer Team. Edwin loved and had hope for his city of Richmond and ran for city

council in the 80's.

He especially loved his devoted wife Carole (Pooh) of 36 years. Who also loved the LORD and reflected so with how she cherished and cared for her husband.
