



## ELAINE LUCK

August 13, 1946 - November 2, 2019

On Saturday, November 2, 2019 in the warmth of a beautiful sunny morning, God in his infinite wisdom whispered her name softly to come home to be with him. Elaine Luck, the daughter of the late Reverend Arthur and Amanda Armstrong, was born in Baltimore, Maryland on August 13, 1946. One of four children she was blessed with faithful, dedicated, loving and godly parents. Elaine matriculated in the Baltimore City Public School and attended Nursing school where she successfully graduated. She worked as a Registered Nurse at the University of Maryland Medical Center Deton for 25 years before her retirement in 2014. Elaine went on to study religious studies and biblical principals at the Baranash Academy of Excellence.

Elaine was united in holy matrimony with Jesse Luck (who preceded in death) on March 26, 1960. She and Jessie were blessed from this union with 6 children, Ray (who preceded her in death), Wanda, Linda Melvin, Valarie, and Renee. She was a kind, strong and loving mother who was exemplary example of a godly parent.

Evangelist Luck gave her life to Christ at a young age in Alpha and Omega Pentecostal Church. She became a member of First Apostolic Church under the leadership of the late Bishop Winfeild Showell and later served the current pastor Bishop Cornelius Showell. During her time at first Apostolic Faith Church, she served in the Women's Ministry, Ushers Board, Intercessory Team and Alter Workers. Evangelist Luck received the call to ministry and was licensed to preach the gospel under Bishop Cornelius Showell. She returned

Later in life, Evangelist Luck dedicated her time to Unconditional Love Church under the late Apostle Thomas Jones and Pastor Gwendolyn Jones where she served as a church mother.
