Eevlon Walker-Edwards was born on September 1, 1945 in Baltimore, MD to the late Gentle Jack Lane. She gained her wings on September 29, 2025, after battling illness. We will miss your smiling eyes, patience, generosity and so much more!

At an early age, she confessed faith in Christ and joined the First Baptist Church of Fairfield under the leadership of Reverend Kenneth Harvard where she remained a member until the Lord called her home.

Eevlon attended the Baltimore City Public School System and received her Diploma in Business Education and a certificate in Bookkeeping.
