A Carver High School graduate, she worked for Lucent Technologies, Inc, for thirty years before retiring in 1997. She returned to Baltimore to be with her family and pursue a life long ambition of caring for the aged. After completing courses in Private Nursing with Baltimore City College, Ella fulfilled her dream and worked as a private day nurse for a host of patients including Congressman (Ret) Parren Mitchell. Ella was a very caring person and opened her home and heart to everyone. She spent most of her spare time collecting antiques (furniture, pottery, jewelry) and clothing-especially pocketbooks. She was a clothing fanatic; not very expensive garments, but durable and fashionable. She could buy a ten-dollar dress from a thrift shop and wear it like a Saks Fifth Avenue designer original. Ella leaves her loving daughter, Candie, two brothers, Lorenzo Louis Simpson and Arthur Henry Simpson to mourn her passage. On brother, Edward Eugene Simpson, who preceded her in death, welcomes her to heaven. Her two sisters-in-law, Margo and Brenda; two former sisters-in-law, Ellen-Jane and Joanne Simpson; her former husband, Donald Smith; eight nieces, eight nephews and a host of great nieces and nephews hold her in loving memory. Her devoted friends, Joyce Thomas and Denise Shackelford are among her closest friends of whom there
