



## Ella M. Harrison

May 7, 1914 - February 6, 2002

Ella Mae Perrin Harrison, youngest daughter of the late Cornelia and Thomas Perrin, was born May 7, 1914, and on February 6, 2002, she departed her earthly home for her heavenly mansion. Ella was born in Chatham, New Jersey and began her education in the New Jersey Education system before her family moved to Price Edward County, VA. She was baptized at the New Hope Baptist Church at an early age. After she moved to Baltimore, she met and married the late Herbert Raymond Harrison on December 15, 1932 by the late Pastor Matthew Wilkerson. From this union there were five children. Leon Raymond Harrison's death preceded his parents. Ella worked for Bickford's Restaurant for 15 years, and later the Londontown Manufacturing Company until she retired. Ella joined the Zion Baptist Church in 1934. She was an active member of the Wednesday Bible Class, Gospel Choir, Voices and Deaconess Ministry. She sang professionally with the True Vine Gospel Singers for ten years. She could play the piano without sheet music and she loved playing for the Tuesday night Prayer Meeting Services, Baptism Services, and Daytime Bible Class. She serviced as a Deaconess at Zion for fifty-eight years before moving to emeritus status. Ella always told all of us "Grandma is going to be alright." She leaves to cherish her memory four children: Alfred P. and Charles Harrison, Thelma McDaniel and Audrey Wright; one daughter-in-law, Mary Ann Harrison; a devoted niece, Dolores Brown; twenty-two grandchildren; forty great-grandchildren, and twenty-five great, great grandchildren (the total of all of her grand's equal eighty-seven, which is

also Ella's passing age); and a host of relatives and friends.
