ELMER AVON DAVAGE was born on October 1, 1927 on Oak Street in Baltimore, MD, the fourth son of the late Morrison Leroy Davage and Daisy Johnson Davage. He quietly passed away on September 4, 2018 at the Westgate Hills Medical Center and Rehabilitation Center.

Elmer was baptized and accepted Christ as his personal savior at an early age. He attended Baltimore Public Schools, graduating from Douglass High School in 1947. Shortly thereafter he volunteered for military service and joined the U.S. Army. Elmer served his country for four years, where he was stationed in Germany, before being honorably discharged.

After completing his military duty, Elmer returned to the United States to be closer to his family and seek unemployment. He was employed at the Social Security Administration in Baltimore, from which he retired after many years of faithful service. During his time there he received numerous accolades for excellent service. He was known for his exceptional penmanship so much so that he was given the responsibility of handwriting many certificates and awards given to fellow employees which he took great pride in.

Elmer enjoyed writing in calligraphy, listening to classical music (particularly Bach and Tchaikovsky), reading and writing poetry, and making up games and puzzles which he enjoyed playing with family members.

Elmer never married and never had any children. He is preceded in death by his brothers Morrison Jr., Robert, Lehman and Ralph. He is survived by his nephews, Steven and Alan Davage of Teaneck, New Jersey, and two favorite cousins, Ernest Gordon and Naon Harris of Baltimore, Maryland. He often playfully referred to these four as his "posse" and loved spending time with them. He leaves other relatives to mourn as well.
