November 20, 1920 - October 17, 2017

Elnora Arlean Jiggetts, the 13th and youngest child of the late Lee and Octavia Jordan, was born on November 2, 1920, in Hanover County, Virginia. She departed this life on October 12, 2017 after battling Alzheimer's.

Most of her family and friends called her Arlean. She received a grade school education in Virginia public schools. Leaving Virginia in the early 1940's, she came to Baltimore and made it her home. Arlean later joined the New St. Mark Baptist Church and served for a time with the Nurses of Mercy.

Arlean married Clinton Earl Jiggetts Sr. on November 5, 1945.

They became the parents of six children. Unfortunately, they lost one son, Barry, in infancy. Arlean became a widow in 1991 after 46 years of marriage. She came to live with her daughter and family in 1998 where she remained until her passing.

Arlean was a dedicated mother, wife, grandmother, great-grandmother, and homemaker. She also held various jobs in her life time. She worked in laundry. She did factory work at the old Western Electric as well as domestic work. In her last job, she worked as a Psychiatric Nurse's Aide at Crownsville Gate Hospital from which she retired in 1983.

Arlean devoted a great portion of her life especially after retiring to taking care of her grandchildren and traveling. She spent extended stays in both Hawaii and Florida with her daughter and family. She also enjoyed

watching baseball and football games. Arlean was the Baltimore Orioles' biggest fan. She also loved playing cards and telling jokes.
