You have to understand the time - I am talking the 1960's - but Emily and I knew no boundaries. It did not matter that I was a scrawny white kid and the rest of the world was in a race riot - we were just lost in the joys of childhood. I spent large amounts of time with my grandparents on Trimble Road and wandered up to Battle Street to play with Emily, Wanda, Dudley, Tub, Weed (God rest his soul), and Ju-Boh (the dog - I think I got that right). Anyway, those years before Middle School and becoming a teenager were the best of my childhood and Emily will remain forever in my heart and memories. I will never forget the night we spent in the fallout shelter in 5th grade where she bet me I could not pull out one of my teeth (it was loose). I managed to pull out three (don't worry, 5th grade is when your new permanent molars are coming in, and the "baby molars" are falling out) and didn't attempt any more since the chaperone said she was going to call our parents and make us go home if I did not stop pulling out teeth. Emily was incredibly impressed and then she and I giggled ourselves to sleep. We played Basketball at EHS, and graduated together in 1974. To all of Muffie's family, those I know and those that I don't - my heart is with you all. Emily will always be a part of me and I was a better person for having known her and all the Bradleys.
