### LIFE REFLECTIONS OF EMMA JEAN

Emma Jean White Anderson was born on August 6, 1950, in Cumberland County, Virginia. Emma was the only child of Estelle White and was nurtured in a tight-knit loving family circle of aunts, uncles, and cousins.

She was her grandmother's namesake and growing up, there would always be lots of people and good times in the family's house. Emma stayed close to home and to her mom and loving aunts: Mary, Pearl, Margaret, Annie, Elsie, and her uncle, John. The family moved to Richmond, Virginia when she was very young, where she matriculated through the Richmond Public school system, graduating from Armstrong High School.

Emma was baptized by the late Reverend John Bishop Gordon and joined the Bethlehem Baptist Church congregation where she worshipped for over 50 years. Around 1966 she met a young very handsome fella with a twinkle in his eye for her. She never imagined that she would go on to share a love of fifty-seven years with the boy from Oakwood Avenue.

On December 8, 1969, she married Herbert "Flick" Anderson and became part of an even bigger family circle. They were together for so long that they became referred to as one person, "Emma and Flick." God orchestrated the very best for Emma with Flick, and even though they seemed opposite; she

was fiery and he was cool, they were truly a match made by heaven.

In 1971, she went to work for the Federal Reserve Bank of Richmond. She worked at the Federal Reserve for over 30 years until she retired. She made many life-long friends at the Fed and kept in close contact with them over the years after retirement .

As a young couple, Emma and Flick set out to build a beautiful life and legacy together. Their first-born daughter, Angela Roxanne, whom she called "Rock" because of her strength, calmness, and steady presence, was Emma's go-to girl to get things done. Next, her firecracker, Latonia Yomi, came along, whom she called her Boo. Latonia carried her feistiness, wittiness, and resilience. Latonia always kept her in some type of shenanigan, and she loved getting in the car and just riding out with her Boo. The family of five was complete with Kenya Lashawn, who was her baby girl, her soft spot, and her sidekick. Wherever you saw Emma, her baby girl Kenya was always right beside her. Kenya possessed her mom's beauty and flair for style. Emma always wanted Kenya to do her hair and makeup, and doll her up. Each of Emma's daughters embodies some aspect of her. They are a reflection of their mother, who was strong and beautiful, feisty and witty, and a woman who could get things done. They are truly Emma's girls.

Emma loved her husband and adored her girls. She unapologetically spoiled them. She made a "Proverbs 31" home for her family and worked to make sure they all enjoyed a beautiful life. Among everything she gave her girls, the most valued gift she and Flick blessed them with was an education, debt-free.

Emma had a missionary's heart. She began her work as a missionary as a teen and would continue missionary work at Bethlehem where she helped to establish the Royal Ambassador and Girls in Action (RA/GA) Youth missionary program along with Deacon Stanley Brown, the late Dr. Victor L. Davis, and

the Richmond Baptist Association. She worked passionately with the RA/GA program, conducting youth bible study, planning missionary activities for the kids, and orchestrating trips across the state to play in basketball tournaments. Through her work with the RA/ GA program, the residue of Aunt Emma's hand remains in the life of many people who grew up in Bethlehem. Emma most recently served as President of the Ladies Auxiliary Usher Board #1 and she was a faithful member of the Tuesday Night Women's Bible Study Class. Emma was delighted to be a member of the Richmond Royals chapter of the Red Hat Society, known as the Red Hatters. She loved the fellowship and fun among the Richmond Royals Red Hatters and faithfully served as the group's treasurer. She was the prettiest Red Hatter to be seen whenever she adorned a beautiful red hat and with her red and purple.

Emma was called by many affectionate and endearing names: " Emma Jean, " "Jeanie," "Mooch," "China Doll," "Em," "Aunt Emma," "Mommy Emma, " and Miss Emma. The name that was most befitting of Emma was simply " momma. "She was great at being a momma! Even before having children of her own, Emma was a momma to her cousins, who she watched over and kept.

After raising her girls, she was blessed with the absolute apple of her eye, Anastasia, who landed in her Aunt Emma's arms one Sunday morning at church. From that moment, they never let go of one another. When Anastasia became too big for her Aunt Emma's infamous rock, along came Jasey Girl. Jase was her Mommy Emm a 's bestie. Jase and Mommy Emma were always up to something and shared a very special bond.

If you knew Emma well, you knew that she liked a cold Pepsi and a neat home. She loved to talk with people and could start a conversation with anyone. She looked forward to going to the Hampton Jazz Festival every

summer and connecting with friends from out of town. She enjoyed talking more than walking with the ladies in her walking group at the track. She especially enjoyed her weekly phone conversations with her oldest niece and her cousin in Waynesboro.

Emma's life was a life well-lived. On March 25, 2022, she labored into rest. She leaves s to cherish her memory, her husband of 53 years, Herbert M. Anderson, and daughters, Angela, Latonia, and Kenya Anderson; her devoted cousin, Lena Burrell, cherished niece Anastasia Rain Daniels, and favorite girl, Jase Mayo; sisters and brothers-in-law, Doris Stokes, Reginald Anderson, Gwendolyn, and Ethan Pitts, Lewis Anderson, and witty and a woman who could get things done. They are truly Emma's girls. Constance Anderson, Lois Anderson, and Bernice L. Anderson; godchildren, Tracee Jones and Michael James; a host of beloved nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends, among them, cousins Henry Ford, Evon Simmons, and Tracey James; and faithful neighbors, William and Candice Payne and Tonya Hester.

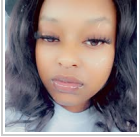
