ERIC MAURICE JORDAN, known by childhood friends as “Ericy”, was born to Venus Delores Jordan- Harris and Eugene William Jordan on January 4, 1955 in Baltimore, Maryland. He departed this life on October 30, 2015 after a short illness.

Eric was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System. Eric was a rambunctious kid causing his mom to make many trips to the principals office. Eric eventually directed his energy to music where he evolved into a accomplished drummer. Eric would use his drumsticks to beat on anything hr could find including his sisters. He and a few friends formed the band “Atmosphere” and became a huge local band who was courted by Berry Gordy, but they were already under contract.

Eric was always a strong willed, outspoken person who protected and adored his family. He worked as a contractor for 25 years working on residential and commercial projects.

Eric came to know the Lord early in his life as his grandmother, Mary Kaster, was the pastor of her own church and had him baptized in Harve De Grace, Maryland under the Apostolic faith.

In 1982, Eric met Debora, who in 1994 became his wife. Together they raised

their family in northeast Baltimore.
