Erma RosaLee Glasscho, daughter of the late Charles and Hazel Williams, Jr, was born on March 25, 1945 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on April 14, 2017.

Erma, affectionately known as Grandcy, RosaLee, Sugar Foot, or Susa Belle, received her education in the Baltimore City Public School system, graduating from Frederick Douglass High School. these two forged a friendship which blossomed into a relationship. On December 16, 1967, they married. From this union, they had three sons: Stanley, who preceded her in death, Samuel, Jr., and Steven .

Erma dedicated her life to the Lord at an early age. Through the Lord, she received her calling to give and care for others. During her 47 years of service at Sinai Hospital, she held many positions. She was often the first person to treat you in the Emergency Room. Many Sinai employees said she built the building and she had the deepest creases in her scrubs that one would ever see. ER7 would never be the same after her retirement. After retirement, Erma filled her days with caring for her husband until his final days. She loved to host her annual 4th of July cookout, fish on Fridays, coupled with spades tournaments at the dining room table. She loved her family and was supportive to everyone she cared for, and there was nothing she would do for them. Erma loved to shop. One can say she singled handedly kept Macy's and Double T Diner in business.

Her shopping wasn't in vain. She always had new outfits to wear as she traveled around the world, dragging luggage and popping tags. Her son and daughter-in-law recently spent time in Las Vegas with her for her 72nd birthday.

She was preceded in death by siblings, Charles Williams, David Williams, Donald Williams, James Williams, and Effie Scott.

She leaves to cherish her memory, two sons, Samuel Glasscho, Jr. and Steven Glasscho (Katrina); one sister Hazel Pearson (Raymond); two brothers, Melvin Williams and Stanley Williams (Ellen); one brother-in-law, Everett Dave Glasscho; two grand-daughters, Cierra

“ There are so many loving memories I could share about Aunt Erma from childhood to adulthood. Ironically, my fondest memory of her was not in a family capacity, but in her role as a Nurse. I was pregnant with my first child and having a really hard time. I was back and forth in the ER at Sinai for dehydration, pregnancy induced hypertension, and all the symptoms that went along with it. There was one particular trip that had Aunt Erma on the shift. I had been sitting there waiting for Lord knows how long and she came walking through the waiting room. She took one look at me and asked "what is going on?" I was really scared and my voice shook as I told her my symptoms. She said, "I'll be right back." The next thing I knew, I was in the back with my IV hooked up, my vitals being taken, and the ER doctor and nurse immediately on hand. She kept telling me "everything's gonna be fine, stay calm, you are in good hands" and other reassuring words. That was Aunt Erma! Her care and concern as a Nurse took away my anxiety about my baby and calmed my spirit. I thanked God for her and prayed that He would send special blessings her way, then and always. It was not just a job for her, it was truly a calling and ministry! Many who experienced her nursing care can acknowledge how blessed they were to have her.

Even after she retired, she still gave me advice and information on our family medical history so that we would always be informed. She said, "you gotta ask questions about your family medical history. It could save your life!" Thank you Aunt Erma for loving me as your Niece, and for showering me with your care as a Nurse. I thank God that I said these words to you while you were with us, and that I can share them with family and friends in your honor.

You know I am lifting our family up in prayer as we remember your rich life and the impact you had on us all! May the Lord be with us to strengthen and comfort us, and keep your memory alive in our hearts and minds always.
