April 16, 1955 - December 7, 2013

On Saturday, December 7, 2013, God in His infinite wisdom, called one of His soldiers, ERNEST QUINTIN WOMBLE to join His army of saints.

Ernest, affectionately known as “Quintin” was born on April 16, 1955 in Baltimore, Maryland to the (late) Ernest Benjamin Womble and Evelyn L. (West) Womble. Ernest was the eldest of five siblings, one of whom, Eric Benjamin Womble, preceded him in death.

At an early age, “Quintin” accepted Christ and began his Christian walk at Mt. Zion United Methodist Church, where he attended Sunday school and church. Later in life, he decided to rededicate his life to Christ and was baptized at Manna Bible Church. “Quintin” during his childhood was a modest, yet prolific artist who performed in several art shows throughout Baltimore City. In many cases he was recognized for such talents. In addition, he served in the Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts (Troop 663). He truly lived up to the scouts' credo of being loyal, helpful, courteous, and friendly. He was an outstanding football player who held the position of half-back at Northwestern High School, from where he graduated in 1973. “Quintin” continued his education at Towson State University, where he majored in Physical Education & Business Administration. He attended Towson on a full athletic scholarship for football. While at Towson, he also worked on the University's radio station.

He was a loving husband and father. In September 1975, he was married to Phyllis Eaton. From this union they were blessed with two children, Shanelle and Shawn. Ernest later remarried to Dorothy DeVane.

Known for his passion for cooking and grilling, he became the family cookout “guru”. His diligence and hard work was admired by all. “Ernie” as he was later affectionately referred by his friends and colleagues, was known for having a quiet, humble and modest demeanor.

Ernest began his career with the development of E.Q. Productions entertainment business, where he helped to promote concerts with entertainers such as, Evelyn Champagne King, Curtis Blow, New Edition and Phyllis Hyman. Ernest ventured on to become a sales representative for Reliable Liquors and advanced to one of the top salesmen in the area. He later met Jesse Wong, founder of Hunan Manor Restaurant and became an intricate part of his team. He developed many friendships and lasting relationships. Subsequently, he became the General Manager at Asean Bistro in Columbia, Maryland, then moved on to become the C.E.O. At Jesse Wong's Hong Kong Restaurant. “Ernie developed an interest in Asian Culture. He traveled several times to Malaysia and learned to speak Mandarin Chinese. Because of his passion for cooking and grilling, he partnered with business associates to create a catering business venture known as “Food Fusion.”
