Her Legacy

Estellena Giles Ridges, affectionately known as Esther, was born on July 30, 1920, in Hanover County, Virginia to James Peter and Mary Elizabeth Giles. She went home to glory peacefully in the presence of her nieces, Cookie and JoJo, and her great-niece, Kristen. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, Andrew, and all eight siblings: Thomas, Frank, James, Isaac, Agnes, Verlanda, Henry, and Joseph.

Esther was raised in Hanover County, Virginia where she attended Hanover County Public Schools. She furthered her education by receiving her Nursing Certification. Esther accepted her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ at an early age and attended her family church until she moved to Delaware around 1941. She worked in Delaware for a few years before moving to Baltimore near other siblings, where she remained until her baby brother, Joe, moved her back home near him to Hanover County once she reached her nineties. Esther flourished and was rooted in activities in Baltimore where she became a member of the Fountain Baptist Church for many years. Later, she moved her membership and was a Charter Member of the Ray of Hope Baptist Church where she worked in many capacities: Trustee, Nurse, Choir Member, Counting Committee, etc. She was an intricate member of her church where she was respected by all and a blessing to many. Once she moved back to

Virginia, she regularly attended Trinity Baptist Church in Richmond, VA with her brother and sister-in-law.

Esther's work career consisted of caring for children, the field of nursing, and she retired from Western Electric Company where she worked as an assembly worker for over 30 years.

Esther was married to Johnny R. Wilkerson, who was the brother of her sister's husband, Agnes, to whom she remained married until his death. Later in life, while she was working at Western Electric, she met and married Andrew Ridges to whom she remained married until his death.

She leaves to cherish her wonderfully, beautiful memory: her sister-in-law, Ruth W. Giles; her godson, Spencer Giles (Vera); many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. There were no children born to either union, but one that she called her own, Barbara Cooper. She also leaves to cherish her memory, her exquisite and caring caretaker, Charlotte Harris of Richmond, Virginia.

Esther loved everything about life, especially her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ and she never complained. She would always say when asked how she was, her response would be "I feel GOOD!! I sleep good, I eat good and GOD has been GOOD to me!" She lived a graceful and long life which God blessed her to see 101 years and 314 days. She was featured on NBC12 on her 100th birthday and even the news reporter could see her radiant beauty and called her BLESSED. She loved to spend time with her family and was the Matriarch of the Giles Family. She also loved to travel, sew, loved jewelry and prided herself in her beautiful fingernails. Esther was an avid dog lover in which she trained, raised and spoiled all of them, one of which "Abby girl" is still being loved and cared for. She would light up the room with her beauty and laughter. As so many of her siblings and family, she never met a stranger, she was loved by all – she was truly OUR BLESSING!!
