Esther Buie, daughter of the late William and Martha Leach, was born in Rennert, North Carolina on the 15th day of February in 1908. She was called to rest on Saturday, November 21, 2002 at 11:15 p.m. She was 94 years old at the time of her departure. Esther received her education in North Carolina. She loved to attend church with her family. Her father was the Superintendent of Sunday School at the Pannaford Baptist Church and she was his Secretary. This was one thing she was very proud of as a child and she told that story often. Mrs. Esther married Simon Obadiah Buie on February 6, 1927. From that union were nine children: five daughters, Lessie Rose, Iona Richburg, Carlee Buie (who preceded her in death), Lillian Harkless and Martha Harvin; and four sons, Simon William, Leodis, Adel and Roosevelt. They moved their family to Baltimore in 1939. Mrs. Esther had a quiet spirit about her. Everyone who met her loved her. She enjoyed caring for her family, home and garden. She also loved to bake cakes and pies and loved to sing while she was cooking. She was very devoted to her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Mrs. Esther attended five churches in Baltimore; Knox Presbyterian, Perkins Square Baptist Church, Mount Hebron Baptist Church, Grater Hope Church of God in Christ and Berea Temple. She felt that Berea was the church where she belonged, although she was raised as a Baptist. Mrs. Esther will be missed by many. She leaves to cherish her memory: four sons, four daughters; two son-in-law, John Rose and James Harvin; two daughters-in-law, Susie and Zelda Buie; forty-four grandchildren,

ninety-five great-grandchildren, sixteen great-great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews, friends, and her cat, Sampson.
