also volunteered at the Monte Verde Apartments where she lived, assisting Pastor Luwanna Nelson.

Esther leaves to cherish her memory, three children: Daniel Bush Jr., David Bush and Diane Bush; one sister, Irene Smith, of Newark, NJ: one daughter-in-law, Ebby Bush; four grandchildren and a host of family and friends.
