Esther Theresa Page, eleventh born child of the late Bessie Althea (Johnson) Page and Herman Claiborne Page, began her earthly journey on February 9, 1948 in a little place called Woodville just outside of Richmond, VA. Along the way she became a product of Richmond Public Schools having attended Woodville elementary, East End middle and later graduating from Armstrong High School. She continued her education at Virginia Union University where she attained a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics. Afterward she taught for a brief spell in the Richmond schools, but eventually chose the private sector in her pursuit of a career. She retired from Aetna Life and Casualty Insurance Companies.

Esther accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized into the Mount Tabor Baptist Church in Richmond. She later became a member of the Faith Community Baptist Church.
