ESTHER LYDIA WILSON, daughter of the late Nathaniel and Bertha Branch, was born on November 1, 1921, the oldest of eight sisters and five brothers.

Esther L. Wilson departed this life early November 26, 2013 after a lengthy illness.

She received her education in the Baltimore, MD public school system.

Married at the early age of seventeen to William Otha Robinson, from this union came three sons, William Otha Robinson Jr., Nathaniel Joseph Robinson and Richard Lee Robinson. She was later remarried to John C. Wilson in the early 1950's, a loving, devoted union which lasted until his death in 1976.
