She must have been a beautiful baby she certainly became a beautiful and loving woman who warmed the hearts of anyone who met her. Ethel attended Wilmington, North Carolina schools and graduated from the historic Williston High School with the Class of 1967.

Ethel relocated to attend North Carolina College at Durham. When she earned her Bachelor's Degree in Sociology in 1971, the college had been renamed North Carolina Central University (NCCU). She became a Double Eagle, earning her Master's Degree in Counseling in 1973. While attending college, Ethel met a handsome law student, William Womble, Jr. After graduation, they launched their careers in Baltimore and remained in the city for over forty-five years. They earned master's degrees together from Johns Hopkins University. Ethel and Bill married on, July 1, 1978, and she was a beautiful bride. They welcomed Lindsay Meredith Womble on October 1, 1983. With the help of special caregiver, Mr. Annette Randolph, they nurtured Lindsay for nearly thirty-four years.

Ethel retired from the State of Maryland Division of Rehabilitation Services after completing thirty-one years of service. She worked as team member of Unit 30 and retired as the unit supervisor June 30, 2008. Her work in the area of rehabilitation enabled her to assist persons with disabilities to enter or

reenter back into the work forces. She taught classes at Coppin State University, where she recognized for her impact on students inside and outside the classroom. After retirement Ethel and Bill traveled the world together. She also explored world adventures with traveling companions from the church visiting multiple continents, including Europe, Asia, and Africa. Sharing love for traveling and exploring the college HAVES-Harriett, Amie, Vicki, Ethel, and Sally celebrated decades friendship in Dominican Republic in 2018.

Ethel had passionate love and commitment for her faith, family and friendship. As a member of Transformational Church of Jesus Christ she was regular in her attendance at worship, Sunday School and ministering kindness to other in and outside the church. Ethel and Bill made an effort to show up for milestone birthday celebrations, family reunions, graduations, weddings and acknowledged the birth of new babies everywhere. She was Diamond Life member of Dela Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated; Baltimore Metropolitan Alumnae Chapter. Membership in this public service organization afforded opportunities to perform community service projects, raise fund for scholarships, and travel with two generations of sister-cousins.

On February 12, 2019, God granted Ethel eternal rest. She was reunited with Lindsay, one of the great loves of her life. Ethel also joined her parents and those of her husband-Beulah Johnson Scott, Franklin Scott, Dorothy Ricks Womble, and William Womble, Sr.
