June 28, 1917 - August 11, 2002

On Sunday, August 11, 2002, Etta Estell Harris Owens went quietly to her eternal rest at Perring Parkway Center in Baltimore, Maryland. She was born in Buckingham County, Virginia, on June 28, 1917, to the late Annie West Nicholas Harris and George Phillip Harris. Etta was educated in the Buckingham County Public School System. At an early age she joined Jerusalem Baptist Church. Later, after moving to Baltimore, Maryland, she moved her membership to Zion Baptist Church where she served for over fifty years. She served on the Lady's Aid, Willing Workers, and Golden Aide; Wednesday Bible Class, Gospel choir and Sunday school until her health failed. There she also met and married Deacon Fred Owens. She worked for the State of Maryland for over twenty years as a Home Health Aid, where she later retired. Etta enjoyed helping and taking care of people. Many young and old knew her in her neighborhood as "Ms. Etta" or "Grandma" because she always showed so much love and kindness to everyone. She always invited the little neighborhood children into her home to give them sweets or ice cream. "Moomie" as she was affectionately called, was a loving, caring mother, grandmother, great grandmother, and sister. She had a quick sense of humor, a sharp tongue, and had no problem with saying what was on her mind. Her husband, Fred; a brother, Clarence Nicholas; and five sisters, Gertrude Lee, Willie P. Seay, Irene F. Mitchell, Mary Stevens, and Christine Logan preceded Etta in death. She leaves to cherish their memories: a devoted daughter, Dolores Chisholm of Baltimore, Md.; three granddaughters;
