May 19, 1916 - December 10, 2015

EUGENIA GERTRUDE FOSTER passed away quietly in her sleep after a short illness on December 10, 2015. Second of four children, she was born to John H. and Suzie A. Lockley in Capahosic, Gloucester, VA May 26, 1916.

Eugenia was educated at the Gloucester Agricultural and Industrial School of Capahosic. She was baptized at Bethel Baptist Church. In the late 30's, early 40's Eugenia moved to New York and then Baltimore and trained as a Welder during World War II. In 1972 she married Richard Foster who preceded her in death. They were happily married for forty-four years.

A highly spiritual person, she joined the Simmons Memorial Church and later the Central Baptist Church, the church of her mother, after she became her caregiver. Although she lived in Baltimore she continued her affiliation with the Bethel Baptist Church in Gloucester. She would send money for the church's Homecoming and for the Pastor's Anniversary.

Eugenia had a beautiful voice, singing with the choirs of the churches she attended. Her favorite singers were the Gospel Quartets. Even in her final days she would be aroused from her deep sleep by prayer and song. She loved family, friends, the Prime Agers group, and short day trips, especially Casinos.

She is survived by: her brother, Robert Lockley; nephews, Michael Locksley, Wayne Lockley and Robert Michael Lockley; nieces, Cheryl Grant and Deborah Lockley; great-niece Ellen Reed Rounds; and other loving relatives and friends.
