Eva was reared in the Richmond Public Schools Systems, graduating from Maggie L. Walker High School. She furthered her studies at Virginia Commonwealth University, J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College, Rappahannock Community College and Sallie Thompson Nursing School. For 18 years, she was employed with Medical College of VA Hospitals. On August 12, 2000, she met and married Eddie National Ross, Sr. She was later employed at King William High School for 10 years where she retired September 2009.
