



## Eva Marie Wimbley

June 11, 1946 - April 27, 2018

Later she worked at Childcare of Windsor, where the families and children loved her care and preschool training.

She lived an exciting vivacious life. She was a compassionate, loving, giving and caring person towards not only her family, but also towards friends and even strangers. She was a mother, grandmother, great grandmother, aunt and cousin. She was a fighter and goal oriented person determined to reach her goals in life to benefit herself and most importantly to benefit her family and others.

Eva has transitioned to eternal life, where she joins her loving Mother, Earline Wimbley, her Step-Son Jeffery M. Irving, and her Grandson Nolan J. Morris.
