EVANGELINE BURRELL, known to all as "Sis", daughter of the late Raymond Smith and Carrie Bailey, was born on January 30, 1926 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on May 8, 2014.

She received her education within the Baltimore City Public School System. During WWII, Evangeline worked as a factory worker assembling military equipment. She worked at Johns Hopkins Hospital for a brief time and then at The University of Maryland Hospital as a Dietary Supervisor, from which she retired in October 1983. She also loved to sew and could make garments that were better than you could get out of a store. She made many of her own clothes and was always asked to do wedding and prom gowns.

On March 13, 1946, she married Isaiah E. Burrell known as Bootsie; and they were together for over 60 years, until God called him home in 2005. From this union they had five children. Her children were her life, and she would make any sacrifice for them, even if it meant "getting that belt out."

Evangeline grew up in South Baltimore on Russell Street. In her earlier years, she worshiped at Ebenezer A.M.E. Church and then later she joined (Little) Ark Church. Evangeline loved the Lord and the hope that is in Him; the hope that she knew when God came to call her home that she would be united with Christ and with her husband again in heaven for eternity.

She leaves to cherish her memory: one daughter, Charlene; three sons, Isaiah Jr., Andre and Michael; two daughters-in-law, Karin and Clarice; twelve grandchildren, twenty great-grandchildren, a host of other relatives and friends.
