Her brothers and sisters formed a special spiritual singing group called the Open Heart Singers, and the host house for rehearsals was Eve's. Glad she lived in the woods, we always made a lot of noise. She supported the group, but knew she could not sing, so she fed us all and tried to keep peace and tried to keep them all together. She loved to dance and have a good time. She enjoyed cruises. No one jumped

up higher when the Electric Slide came on than Eve. She would call everyone to join her on the dance floor, but she was always ten feet in front of you. Dressing up was another favorite thing to do. She had the most clothes of everyone on the cruises and wore them well. Every event was a fashion show. For Eve everything had to match; shoes, earring, nails and purse. She enjoyed life. Her energy, beautiful smile and presence will live on in all of us forever. She will be missed. She touched everyone she met, and it's evident by the loving support in this poem. James and Eve dedicated themselves to serving Jehovah over twenty-one years ago, and gained over 61 million new friends worldwide. During her illness, she remained faithful and kept her integrity to Jehovah. Even though she could not physically attend the Kingdom Hall, the elders and brothers made sure she was tied in by speakerphone to make her meetings every Wednesday and Sunday. She never missed the services. She was lovingly given the name Sister Cook by her new friends because she made the best potato salad and pretzel salad. Eve became ill two years ago with cancer. Myra James helped her find good doctors to help her through her illness. She lost the battle on January 29, 2002 at 7:00 p.m. At her home with her children.
