Evelyn was educated in the Baltimore City Public School System and attended Dunbar High School. She married Thomas E. Jones, Sr. on December 25, 1942. He preceded her in death. From this union four children were born. For a short period of time, she became a part-time employee of the United States Postal Service, but she left to be a full-time Mom to her four children as well as many others who called affectionately called her "Nan." She loved cooking and sharing food at family gatherings and also providing care and lodging for many. This led her to become a home provider to share her god-given skills with others. Before her illness, she enjoyed taking care of her grandchildren, relatives and great-grandchildren.

Later, she moved her fellowship to the Church of God in Lothian, Maryland. She served under the leadership of the late Elder Raymond C. Wills and the late George W. Hawkins, Sr. She maintained her membership until her departure under the pastorate of Pastor Derek Hawkins. Evelyn exhibited the love of Christ toward everyone with whom she came in contact. She pursued a personal relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ, and

joyfully looked forward to one day gaining her heavenly reward.

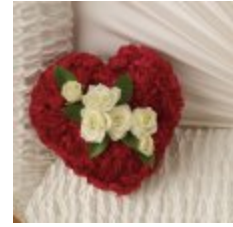
