Evelyn tutored young people in reading and was passionate about teaching and education. As she was prone to say, "Children are my top priority."

Evelyn met and married the late Elmer Lester Lambson. They were blessed with five children: Althea, Rodney, Andrea, Laura and Karl.

Nana, as she was affectionately known to many, was "feisty" in her own way, yet lived a very active life. She enjoyed traveling, bowling and worked at the Board of Elections as a Chief Judge for more than thirty years. She also took in and cared for many children throughout her lifetime.

Evelyn loved the Lord. She was baptized Catholic, but later jointed the Holiness faith. She was a woman of strong faith and had a special

interpersonal relationship with the Lord. Thus, she committed herself and her life to serving God. She was a devoted member of King's Deliverance Holiness Church Inc. under the leadership of Bishop John Jones. Mother Lambson, as she was known by her family, served on both the local and national levels.
