She had some many books, they were stacked everywhere.

She was also known for the amazing way she was able to take self-rising

cornmeal (had to be yellow bag) and water and a pan of grease and make the corncakes that everyone was crazy about. Adding to the meal would be fried fish.

Now the one thing that bugged me about her was wherever you have an ailment, be it a stomach ache, a back ache, a headache or just not feeling good, her famous words would be "ME TOO". I am going to miss that "ME TOO".

She was preceded in death by her father, Fred Tally, loving mother Clara Mae Spruill, and sister, Nannie Gray.

She leaves to cherish her memory three sisters; Margaret Yarborough of Center Moriches, New York, devoted and caring Clara M. Holloway, and Elisa Glover of Henderson, North Carolina; one loving brother George L. Holloway {Ruth} of Henderson, North Carolina; four nieces; devoted Renay Barnes; four nephews; great-nieces and great-nephews, and a host of other relatives and caring friends.
