Faith was educated in Baltimore City Public Schools graduating from Dunbar Senior High School. She was certified in Operating Room Technology from CCBC. Faith also attended Washington Bible College earning a Bachelor's Degree in Biblical Studies. She also received certification in Pastoral Counseling from Sarasota Academy of Christian Counseling.

Faith was the author of the book "God brought me through divorce" and the composer of the song Hallelujah the lifter of my head. Faith was also an ordained Minister of the Gospel. She was a faithful member of Rock City Church until her passing.

Faith was married to the late Robert Joseph McNair.
