Fletcher (Al) Alphonso Walker, Retired Sergeant First Class, was born to the late John H. Walker and Doris Lucille Walker on December 20, 1952 in Mecklenburg County, Virginia. After a lengthy illness, on July 11, 2019, Al peacefully departed this earthly life at his home in Richmond, Virginia.
