



## Florence L. Fennell

July 6, 1927 - January 7, 2019

FLORENCE LORRAINE LOGAN FENNEL, the fourth daughter of the fifteen children of the late Lawrence D. Logan Sr. and the late Maggie “Mummum” Cook Logan, was born on July 6, 1927 in Baltimore, Maryland. She departed this life on January 7, 2019.

She graduated from Dunbar High School in Baltimore in 1944. She worked at Kreiger Drugstore on Poplar Grove Street and Lafayette Avenue. After that, she was employed by the federal government at the US Social Security Administration’s Office in Woodlawn. Her last job was the one she enjoyed the most; she was the receptionist at the Homecoming Realty, a real estate company owned by her sister, Ida Logan Wyatt. During her lifetime, she was a member of St. Paul’s Baptist Church and Wayland Baptist Church. Her faith remained important to her throughout her life.

Florence was twice married. She married the late Herman Paxton, and out of this union, three children were born – the late Margaret Anne (3/30/49 – 5/18/17), Frances Elizabeth (1952), and the late Kevin Neil Paxton (11/12/54 -9/23/10). This union ended in divorce. In 1956, she married the late Henry Fennell of Rose Hill, South Carolina. One child was born from this union – Vera Leigh (8/1/57).

Florence made friends wherever she went. She was a generous and

supportive friend and relative, helping her numerous nieces and nephews when they needed her most. She was devoted to her family and fought for her son to be admitted to the Maryland School for the Blind in the 1970s.

In the last five years of her long and fruitful life, Florence opened a new chapter. She became a resident of the Eric and Erika's Home of Care II assisted-living facility and was blessed with another group of new friends who supported her to the end of this life. She was as loved at the end of her life as she was at the beginning.

Her loss will be mourned by her daughter, Vera Leigh Fennell; her sister, Ida Logan Wyatt; two brothers, Gary and Ralph V. Logan; nieces and nephews, especially Charlotte Diane Thompson, and a host of other relatives and friends.
