Florine Emily Huey was born on March 18, 1920 at the Franklin Square Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. She was the only daughter born to the late Emma Scott. Flo received her early education in the Baltimore City Public Schools and attended Douglass High School until 1936. Florine left school early to seek employment so she could contribute to the household income. Her first job was at women's hospital. From there, she joined the housekeeping staff at Maryland General Hospital, then moved on to Continental Can Company. In 1938, Florine married the late Lawrence Huey. They had two children, a daughter, Marlene Patrice and a son, Wayne Lee. Flo was a hard, dependable worker. During World War I, she worked on the Pennsylvania Railroad digging ditches and sorting iron. She also picked beans and tomatoes on farms in the Maryland suburbs. Later employment included packing rubber heels and soles at Hold Tight, Inc. and catering elegant parties at Blue Crest. Flo continued to work even after retirement. In the 1990's she joined the staff of the senior aid program. She enjoyed caring for the elderly of our community who were no longer as energetic as she was. Wherever she went, "Miss Flo" was beloved and respected. Se leaves to cherish her memory: her children, Marlene and Wayne; nineteen grandchildren, five great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren; and daughter-in-law, Gwendolyn Huey.
