FLORINE (FLO) JUANITA WHEELER, daughter of the late Ella Yarborough and the late Floyd Guye, was born on December 7, 1939. She departed this life on February 21, 2014.

Florine grew up in Baltimore, Maryland and was educated in the city school system. Her religious beliefs were instilled at St. Francis Xavier Catholic School and Church. Later she became a faithful member of St. Ann's Catholic Church for over 56 years. Here she served on many ministries and committees including the Knights of Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary, finance committee, and choir.
