FOREST C. GWYNN, SR, son of William Henry Gwynn and Ollie Willis Gwynn, was born on May 4, 1924 in Reidsville, North Carolina. Forest was one of fourteen children. He departed this life on July 27, 2009 after a lengthy illness. He received his education in the public schools North Carolina. At the age of eighteen he entered the U.S. Army. During his military years, Forest served in World War II. Upon the completion of his military duty, Forest made his home in Baltimore, Maryland. Forest spent more than twenty-five years as a civil service worker. For the majority of his career he worked at the Baltimore National Veterans Cemetery.
