Affectionately called “Ford”, “Junior” and “Pop Pop”, he pursued most of his educational and spiritual endeavors in Hollywood, Md. At age 17, Ford joined the U.S. Army. He served in World War II and received an honorable discharge. He later pursued a career with the U.S. Postal Service as a mail earner.

While visiting his brother, Joseph, at Henryton Hospital, he met the love of his life, Mildred Irene Winston. They were united in marriage in February 1951.
